I. JUDAS WAS A NUMBER ON THE ROLL

- A. HE WAS ON THE ROLL, BUT NOT IN THE GROUP
- B. MANY CHURCH MEMBERS ARE LIKE THIS TODAY

II. JUDAS WAS A "HAS BEEN"

- A. HE "WAS" NUMBERED WITH THEM (V. 17)
- B. MANY CHURCH MEMBERS ARE IN THIS CONDITION
- C. SATISFACTION IN PAST ACCOMPLISHMENTS DOES NOT GET THE JOB DONE

III. JUDAS WAS THE TRAGEDY OF AN UNWORKED CLAIM

- A. HE WAS IN THE CIRCLE OF DISCPLES
- B. HE HAD A "CLAIM" BUT DIDN'T WORK IT
- C. ARE YOU TAKING ADVANTAGES OF YOUR OPPORTUNITIES?

IV. JUDAS WAS A MAN CONTROLLED BY GREED INSTEAD OF GOD

- A. HE BOUGHT SOME LAND (V 18)
- B. HE STOLE FROM JESUS AND THE DISCIPLES
- C. HIS LAND BECAME HIS TOMB
- D. WHAT IS THE CONTROLLING FORCE IN YOUR LIFE?
